PCUSA Interview Summary from Judy Allton:

People interviewed April 16-18, 2019, in Bassett Library: Kim Kinzler, Don & Helen Teegarden, Blaine & Mary Goeckler, Bill & Sherry Straight, Beth Marshall (daughter for Bill & Sherry), Sylvia Kinzler, James Kinzler, Mary Lawrence, Carol Owens, Pat Brackett, JoAnne Carr, Betty Geehan, Rev. Helen Deleon, Clay Anderson, Missy Rorrer. In addition, Judy Allton was filmed at the Apollo lunar sample facility under auspices of JSC media.

Those interviewed 4/16 through 2 pm 4/18 were participants in the Apollo era, The afternoon of 4/18 allowed interviews of Pastor Helen, Shuttle/Station astronaut Clay Anderson, and Missy Rorrer who related the Bay Area Museum and plans for this year's Lunar Communion celebration.

No one from the pre-NASA congregation responded to the call for interviews; thus, their stories were not captured. It is possible that Rick Jones may pursue remote interviews of Rev.Keith Uffman and others. Rick Jones' videographer was Randy Hobson, of Louisville. JSC historian Jennifer Ross-nazzal also participated in the interviews.

My understanding is that Rick Jones will send to WPC a copy of the raw footage and also the edited versions that they create. The Presbyterian Historical Society in Philadelphia will also get a copy of the complete interviews. Someone on behalf of the Session may want to follow-up with a written agreement of understanding.
