We are changing the form's name from Minute for Ministry & Mission to simply Minute for Ministry, recognizing that Mission is a ministry too. We need to make sure people who want to present those in a worship service submit a completed form (2) weeks prior to the Sunday in question. The form is found in the Family of Faith Section of our website.

Also, we want to remind everyone there is also a form to request space in the Narthex as well as one for usage for all spaces on the campus.

Glenn and Mary are working to streamline the bulletin production process. Judy also brought up the need for Liz to create a folder on her computer to dump information on worship services, funerals, and weddings so that "early-bird" information can be placed there, and that each event needs to have its own folder. This will help immensely for memorial services.
